FALL LEAF & BRUSH COLLECTION

Township Greene will be commencing Fall leaf & brush pick-up November 13, 2007 through November 30, 2007. This operation will begin in the easternmost portion of Greene Township in the Fayetteville area and will move west until completed. The collection crew will make ONE pass through the Township. Please rake your leaves and place brush at the edge of your yard, no further than four feet from the edge of the pavement of the road. Do not bag your leaves The leaves and brush must be on separate piles in order for the township machinery to collect it and must be placed for pick up on the first day of the collection schedule. If the brush and leaves are not separated, they will not be collected

Greene Township will be commencing Christmas Tree collection December 27, 2007 through January 18, 2008.

Trees must be placed at the edge of your yard no further than four feet from the pavement of the road for collection.

GREENE TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY SEWER CUSTOMERS

NOTICE OF RATE INCREASE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 15, 2008

At the regular meeting of the Greene Township Municipal Authority on September 12, 2007, it was approved to increase our quarterly sewer rates effective January 15, 2008.

Our last quarterly increase was in JANUARY of 1995.

Beginning with your January 15, 2008 billing the rates will be as follows: Rates will **INCREASE** from **\$66.00** a quarter to **\$96.00** per quarter per E.D.U

Metered rate will **INCREASE** from **\$5.50** per 1000 gallons of usage to **\$8.00** per 1000 gallons of usage per quarter.

Also, effective January 15, 2008, we will start accepting credit card payments. Information regarding credit card payments will be included in your January 15, 2008 bill.

Halloween can be a time of fun and festivity Follow these simple tips provided by the Home Safety Council (<u>www.homesafetycouncil.org</u>) to ensure safety during this time as well:

- Only permit trick-or-treating at the homes of friends and neighbors you know well
- When purchasing costumes and accessories, buy only those marked "flame retardant" or "flame resistant". Avoid costumes made of long, flowing material and accessories that can move or blow over open flames.
- Choose costumes that are light, bright and clearly visible. Apply reflective tape to the front and back of costumes to help motorists see your child.
- Avoid costumes that block your child's vision and increase the risk of a fall. To keep vision clear, consider using face paint instead of a mask
- Give your child a flashlight to light the way and signal drivers of his or her presence. Never carry candles, torches or other open flames as part of a costume.
- Examine all treats thoroughly before allowing children to eat them. Throw away open treats, those not in their original wrapping and homemade goodies from unknown sources. Slice open fruit to check for foreign objects.

Composting Facility

The Greene Township yard waste composting facility will continue to be open Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. This schedule will continue throughout the year except on holidays, holiday weekends or special events such as bulk collection days. If the compost facility will be closed, signs will be posted at the gates.

The composting facility accepts most types of yard waste except grass clippings. All material generated by the composting facility is available only to current township residents at a cost of \$5 00 per bucket scoop. At various times during the year, after completing the composting process, leaf compost and bark mulch are available for pick-up. Material is on a first come first served basis. You may stop by the facility on Mickey's Inn Road during regular hours to check on availability.

The Greene Township yard waste composting facility is a service provided by the Greene Township Board of Supervisors and is partially funded through recycling grants provided by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection.
