#### **NEW TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT WALKER AND KOHLER ROAD SET TO IMPROVE SAFETY IN CHAMBERSBURG AREA**

Greene Township, Franklin County – Drivers in Chambersburg will soon see a major improvement in traffic safety and flow. The next phase of the North Chambersburg Improvements project kicks off in late March with the installation of a new traffic signal at the busy Walker and Kohler Road intersection.

This upgrade is part of a decade long effort to modernize local infrastructure and enhance safety. Previous phases have already delivered significant improvements, including:

- Extending Parkwood Drive north to connect with Grand Point and Kohler Roads
- Reconstructing and extending St. Paul Drive to intersect with Parkwood Drive
- Enhancing the Fifth Avenue and Norland Avenue intersection
- Extending Fifth Avenue from the municipal line to Parkwood Drive
- Installing the first signal at Kohler and Grand Point Roads

“The signal at Walker and Kohler is desperately needed and we are happy to see it move forward. This project is about making a daily difference. Reducing crashes, improving predictability, and ensuring everyone can move through this corridor safely and confidently” said Todd Burns, chairman of the Greene Township Board of Supervisors. “We are deeply appreciative of the continued collaboration and support from Senator Doug Mastriano and Representative Rob Kauffman, who have helped us secure state funding to advance these critical transportation improvements. Additionally, we are grateful for our municipal partner in this project – the Borough of Chambersburg – who also plays a vital role in advancing improvements in this corridor.”

Once the signal is installed, future planned work includes:

- Extension of Fifth Avenue to provide connectivity between Parkwood Drive and Kohler Road
- Construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Fifth Avenue and Parkwood Drive
- Construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Fifth Avenue and existing Kohler Road
- 

When completed, this transportation network integration project will improve local road infrastructure, address existing safety concerns, and accommodate continued economic development in a targeted growth area.

Over the next few weeks, preliminary survey work, utility location, and preparation of signal foundations will begin. As work progresses, contractors are committed to minimizing disruptions and ensuring safe travel for residents and commuters.

No traffic restrictions or lane closures will occur between 6:00am and 9:00am or between 3:00pm and 6:00pm, Monday through Friday, or on legal holidays and holiday weekends.
