

Title 25. PA CODE Chapter 102 regulations and NPDES Permit requirements

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Chapter 102.4 (b) – Activities other than plowing and tilling (residential, commercial, industrial)

A person **proposing to disturb up to 5,000 sq. feet** should be implementing erosion and sediment control/ Best Management Practices (BMPs) -such as properly trenched in silt fence, stabilized construction entrance, seed and straw mulch.

A person **proposing to disturb over 5,000 sq. feet** up to under 1 acre is required to develop an erosion and sediment control plan and properly implement and maintain the BMPs.

A person **proposing to disturb 1 acre or more** will need to apply for and submit a NPDES application to the Franklin County Conservation District office. The applicant will need to receive approval and permit prior to doing any earthmoving.

Chapter 102.43 Withholding permits

*With the exception of local stormwater approvals or authorizations, a municipality or county **may not issue a building or other permit or approval** to those proposing or conducting earth disturbance activities or requiring a Department permit until the Department or a conservation district has issued the E&S individual NPDES Permit, or approved coverage under the general NPDES Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Construction Activities under section 102.5 (relating to permit requirements).*
